Sunnyside Garden

This weekend I have been clearing the flowering plants from the tubs at the front of the house. I have also been planting some crocus bulbs in smaller pots for outside in the spring. First I put a layer of bulb compost in the pot and arranged the bulbs pointing upwards. Then I covered the bulbs with more compost and finally added a layer of grit. Thesis grit will help to stop the rain splashing on the soil and young plants. I can leave these outside in a sheltered spot and wait for the leaves to grow.

I have also moved some of my trays of seedlings from the greenhouse to the cold frame for the winter. I want them to grow slowly and then I can plant them outside next year.

Have you noticed how the leaves are changing colour on lots of trees. Some turn yellow, some brown and some red. When you are out during half term have a look at the changes that are taking place in the countryside. Most of the leaves will come off the trees in the next few weeks.
