#### Headteacher's message

As a school our attendance is sitting at 95%, which is a credit to your hard work and the value you all have in education, so I thank you for that. It is really important that we continue to work together to do all we can to prioritise the children's attendance at school so that they can enjoy their learning and socialising with their peers. The governors and I have attendance as a key priority for the school and starting after Easter, we will be implementing stricter measures for unauthorised absences. Statistics show that pupils with good attendance have higher attainment in school and studies show that children with attendance above 96% make better progress socially and academically. With the focus and development on the curriculum that has taken place at school then children who are absent will find gaps in their sequential knowledge.

Finally, from me, could I please remind all parents and carers that if you drive to school, please park well away from the school - the school car park is not to be used, nor should any vehicle be stopping on the zigzag lines. There have been repeated requests for this and this potentially dangerous behaviour is continuing. For the safety of all of our children I politely request that this guidance is adhered to. Thank you in advance.

#### **Fixed Penalty Notice**

Following a governors' meeting on Monday night and advice from the Local Authority, St Helena's will start to issue Fixed Penalty Notices with regard to non-school attendance from Tuesday 16th April, 2024.

Non-school attendance includes any day when a child should be in attendance at school and they are absent without the authorisation of the school and it includes unauthorised holidays during term time, persistend absence and persistent late arrival at school beyond the registration period. School starts at 8:50am and registration closes at 9am. Lates will be recorded after this time.

If you wish to seek approval for any request of absence for your child from school, then you must apply in writing to the Headteacher at least 4 weeks in advance of the dates of absence. You should only then remove your child if the absence has been authorised, and notified to you in writing by the school. Any exceptional circumstances must be clearly set out in the written request to the Headteacher who will consider each case upon its merits.

Failure to pay the Fixed Penalty may result in further legal action being taken against you.
