## Valuing Community, Compassion, Friendship, Hope, Respect, Thankfulness, Wisdom and Endurance

#### Governors' Allowances Policy

This policy statement has been developed in accordance with the Education (Governors' Allowances) Regulations 2003. These regulations give Governing Bodies the discretion to pay allowances from the school's annual budget allocation to governors for certain allowances which they incur in carrying out their duties.

St Helena's School Governing Body believes that paying governors' allowances, in specific categories as set out below, is important in ensuring equality of opportunity to serve as governors for all members of the community and so is an appropriate use of school funds. The specific items allowable reflect this objective.

# From January 22<sup>nd</sup> 2018, all governors of St Helena's CE Primary School will be entitled to claim the actual costs, which they incur as follows:

- 1. Governors will be able to claim allowances providing the allowances are incurred in carrying out their duties, as a Governor, and are agreed by the Fabrics' Committee that they are justified before any reimbursable costs are incurred.
- 2. Governors will be able to claim for the following, on a case-by-case basis and with the prior approval of the Governing Body:
- The extra costs they incur in performing their duties either because they have special needs or because English is not their first language;
- The cost of travel relating only to travel to training courses at a rate of 24 pence per mile which does not exceed the specified rates for school personnel;
- Travel and subsistence costs, payable at the current rates specified by the Secretary of State for the Environment, Transport and the Regions, associated with attending national meetings or training events, unless these costs can be claimed from the LEA or any other source

Childcare issues must be raised with the Chair of Governors and then meetings could be periodically re-arranged for such a time that the school's out of hours "After School Fun Club" or Nursery could be accessed free of charge.

#### The Governing Body acknowledges that:

- Governors may not be paid attendance allowance;
- Governors may not be reimbursed for loss of earnings.

Governors wishing to make claims under these arrangements, once prior approval has been sought, should complete a claims form (obtainable from the School Office),

attaching receipts where possible, and return it to the School within two weeks of the date when the allowances were incurred, when they will be submitted for approval by the Chair of Governors or Chair of Finance to be presented to the Fabrics' Committee (which meets at least once per term) for final approval.

Claims will be subject to independent audit and may be investigated by the Chair of Governors (or Chair of Finance in respect of the Chair of Governors) if they appear excessive or inconsistent.

This policy will be reviewed annually.
