Breakfast Club is £2.00 per child per day


School Dinners are £2.50 per meal per day

Unfortunately, credit is not available. Payment should be made in advance or on the day. Payment can be made via Parentmail or at the school office at the time of booking. If payments do go in arrears these facilities will no longer be available to you until payment is made in full.

Attendance

From 31st August 2024 the government is changing the attendance rules. Only 2 penalty notices can be issued to the same parent in respect of the same child within a 3 year rolling period and any second notice within that period is charged at a higher rate:



- A second penalty notice issued to the same parent in respect of the same pupil is charged at a flat rate of £160 if paid within 28 days.
- If a third or subsequent periods of absence are met within 3 years, alternative action will be taken instead, this may include prosecution which may result in a criminal record.
- A child's general attendance is being monitored by the DfE and will also be subject to a potential Fixed Penalty Notice.
- In cases where a pupil has moved school or local authority area the attendance information will continue with the child.

School Transport for September 2024

If your child is starting primary school or transferring to secondary school in September 2024 they may be eligible for school transport. If you think your child is eligible please apply for transport as soon as you have your offer of a school place (1 March for secondary school or 16 April for primary). Early transport applications are encouraged to ensure that transport is in place in time for the start of the September term. Applications can be made online at the website below or a telephone application can be made by contacting the Customer Service Centre on 01522 782020.

Bus Passes should be with children by the end of July.

Young people moving to sixth form or college, who think they are eligible for school/college transport will need to apply for transport using the link below. Please note that there is a charge for post 16 transport provision.




